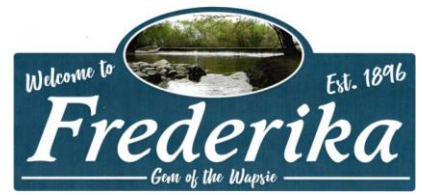
Community info and helpful reminders:

- City Council meetings are held on the 3rd Wednesday of the month at 6:30 pm in the Community Building. Council meeting agenda, minutes, and public notices are posted in the Post Office, Security State Bank, Frederika Locker. Meeting minutes are published in the Tripoli Leader newspaper.
- Fire Department consists of volunteers from residents of the City and surrounding townships. Meetings on the first Tuesday every month beginning at 7:30 PM at the Fire Station/Community Building. New fire fighter and EMS volunteers are always welcome.
- Building Permit applications are required for new buildings, additions, accessory buildings, fences, cement work, etc. Contact Caleb Farlinger 641-420-3070 before beginning construction. Building permit applications are available on-line at the mySecurityStateBank website under the Resources menu Community Links page.
- Alliant Energy supplies electrical services within Frederika. No natural gas lines are located within the City.
- LP Gas service is provided through Consolidated Energy from Jesup, Lou's LP Inc from Nashua, and Farmers Winn Coop from Fredericksburg.
- Butler-Bremer Communications is the local telephone company that offers land phone, fiber optic digital TV and internet service.
- Garbage collection occurs on Tuesday by Waste Management unless a Monday is a holiday. If this occurs, garbage collection occurs on Wednesday. Garbage containers are provided by Waste Management. One 96-gal container is allowed per week. Excess garbage requires sticker purchased from City Clerk at \$3.00 per 50-pounds. Recycling collection occurs every other Tuesday by Waste Management in the morning. Recycling containers are provided by Waste Management.
- Sanitary sewer and garbage collection fees are combined on the same monthly billing that is managed by the City. When establishing an account, you are to communicate whether you are purchasing or renting the property. If renting, landlord information will be needed along with a deposit.
- Pressurized potable water is supplied by Iowa Regional Utilities Association (IRUA) from Waverly to properties within Frederika. Accounts are managed through IRUA.
- Churches located in town: United Methodist Church located on 2nd Ave and St John Lutheran Church located on 4th Ave.
- Post Office service is provided from 8:00 am. till noon on weekdays, and 8-10 am on Saturday mornings. The post office box area is open 24/7.
- Security State is open 7:30 am - 3:30 pm during the week & open until 4:00 pm on Fridays open on open Saturdays from 7:30 am – 11:00 am. ATM is available 24/7 in the front door lobby.
- Rascals Frederika Tap is open Wednesday through Sunday. Sells beer/alcohol and various prepared food.
- Frederika Locker sells a vast selection of cheese, smoked products, and frozen meat packages.

- City Park along 4th Ave has various children playground equipment and a fort climbing area with adult supervision required. A shelter with picnic tables is available for family gatherings with restrooms located on the back side of a concession stand. Contact City Clerk at 319-275-4301 for rental requirements.
- East and West Alcock Parks are managed by the Bremer County Conservation Board (319-882-4742). Regular meetings are held the first Wednesday of the month at 1104 S Main St Tripoli.
- Golf carts are allowed to travel on streets within town per Chapter 76 of the City Code with minimal traffic on County roads (1st Ave and 4th Street).
- ATVs, UTVs, and Snowmobiles are allowed to travel on streets per Chapter 75 of the City Code.
- Open burning is allowed on any day of the week per Chapter 105.05 and Chapter 135.08 of the City Code. A fire permit from the Fire Chief is required for burning ditches and large open areas.
- Fireworks regulations: Consumer fireworks are permitted only on June 25 through July 8 and December 24 through January 3. Please review City Code Section 41.14 for time periods and other regulations.
- The annual City celebration occurs around the Fourth of July holiday with several events all around the community.
- The Community Building located on 2nd Ave may be rented to hold family gatherings and special events. Contact the City Clerk at 319-275-4301 for rental requirements. Refer to mySecurityStateBank website under the Resources menu Community Links page for the regular scheduled activities held at the Community Building, and links to a Building Permit Application and City Code.
