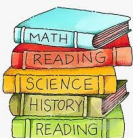

## Corn and Beans

As of this writing, cash corn is \$6.41 and soybeans are \$13.83. Corn is \$.17 lower and soybeans are \$.59 lower than one month ago. May corn futures are \$6.29 with support at \$6.25 and then at \$6.13, resistance is at \$6.38 and then at \$6.51. May soybean futures are \$14.49 with support at \$14.37 and then at \$14.08, resistance is at \$14.65 and then at \$14.94. Yesterday the Federal Reserve raised interest rates .25% as they try to bring inflation down without crashing the US economy, a tough assignment. The recent pressure in soybeans and soybean meal is coming from heavy fund liquidation as a result of a risk-off mentality due to concerns about our economy. November soybean futures dropped \$1.30 per bushel since the last week of February. Funds are believed to be net short 70,000 contracts of corn now. That would be selling roughly 1.3 million bushels over the last three weeks. This morning corn futures are higher as rumors of

additional Chinese business circulate. In nine days, China has come in to buy nearly 96 million bushels of US corn with rumors of another additional buy. These are the first major purchases they've made in several months. Export sales of corn and soybeans remain under last years numbers supporting the move lower in prices. Hopefully we can get some more price recovery between now and mid-June. Unfortunately without some black swan event our highs for old and new crop are likely in and any recover rallies will be lower than previous highs. Use rallies to make sales.
