Corn and Beans

As of this writing, cash corn is \$4.53 and soybeans are \$13.00. Corn is \$.13 lower and soybeans are \$.57 higher than one month ago. December corn futures are \$4.67 with support at \$4.64 and then at \$4.55, resistance is at \$4.72 and then at ■ \$4.80. January soybean futures are \$13.40 with support at \$13.30 and then at \$13.06, resistance is at \$13.55 and then at \$13.80. USDA increased the corn yield by 1.9 bushels per acre. From 173 to 174.9, increasing carryover by 45 million bushels even with a higher usage forecast. Carryover is now estimated at 2.156 billion bushell, stocks to usage ratio of 15.1%, the highest in the last 5 years. World ending stocks increased from 312.4 mmt to 314.99 mmt, last year's world carryover was 299.22 mmt. Soybean yield was also

raised but not enough to negatively affect prices. Dry weather in South America has been providing support to the soybean market for the last month. However, even if South American yields are down they still could set a production record due to increased acres. If dry weather continues South American delays in the Safrinha corn crop might be harder hit due to later planting into the hottest and driest part of their growing season. The U.S. planting season is still 5 months away but most are predicting soybean acres to increase verses corn acres for 2024 due to the current corn/soybean ratio. Current corn prices seem low compared to the last two years but with 15% stocks to usage ratio rallies need to be rewarded with sales. If soybeans recover from last weeks hard drop they also need to be rewarded with sales. Bull markets like we saw start in 2020 build

supplies and ration demand to the point of declining prices followed by a bear market like what started in 2023. This is followed by several years of flat sideways base building. Feel free to contact Logan or myself with your marketing plans or concerns.


