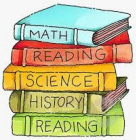

As of this writing, cash corn is \$6.45 and soybeans are \$14.35. Corn is \$.04 higher and soybeans are \$.52 higher than one month ago. July corn futures are \$6.26 with support at \$6.19 and then at \$6.04, resistance is at \$6.34 and then at \$6.50. July soybean futures are \$14.68 with support at \$14.60 and then at \$14.44, resistance is at \$14.76 and then at \$14.93. As I write this markets have turned lower the last 2 days. US weather forecasts for June, July, and August were friendly in the updated models. If correct a high probability of near-trendline yields is expected. That would allow US balance sheets to grow to a health level causing further price declines. We are just getting started planting in the US but the market feels some risk premium can come out of prices for now. Weekly export reports out today were disappointing.
