Corn and Beans

As of this writing, cash corn is \$6.78 and sovbeans are \$14.37. corn is \$1.08 lower and soybeans are \$2.67 Iower than one month ago. September corn futures are \$5.93 with support at \$5.82 and then at \$5.56, resistance is at \$6.08 and then at \$6.34. September soybean futures are \$13.54 with resistance at \$13.54 and then at \$13.11 with support at \$13.97 and then at \$14.40. Last weeks USDA monthly supply and demand report wasn't a shocker but did reinforce that supplies are somewhat tight for corn and tighter for soybeans. The question is if demand will be softer and not matter that we have tighter supplies. Historically usage drops when the economy experiences recessions and the old saying is "the cure for high prices is high prices." Alternatives are found

and more acres are brought into production everywhere around the world. Weather could cause some concerns and move the market back up to recover part of the market loss temporarily. To quote Richard Brock "The trend is your friend. Bull markets always go higher than expected. This past one did. Bear markets always go lower than expected. This one will too. Making adjustments psychologically can be challenging. But it must be done." As hard as that is to read it is true, markets only move up for so long and then move lower again. We have had an upward market for almost 2 years now. The positive for us is our crops are behind normal maturity but looks pretty good as a whole.


