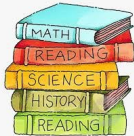

Corn and Beans

As of this writing, cash corn is \$7.86 and soybeans are \$17.04. Corn is \$.05 higher and soybeans are \$.82 higher than one month ago. July corn futures are \$7.86 with support at \$7.76 and then at \$7.57, resistance is at \$7.95 and then at \$8.14. July soybean futures are \$17.04 with support at \$16.94 and then at \$16.69, resistance is at \$17.19 and then at \$17.44. Corn and soybeans continue to be volatile while the market waits to be the month-end acreage report. Weather is the biggest factor affecting the market until the acreage report. The soybean market is concerned about how many acres were lost and lower yields due to later planting. Soybean meal and oil haven't followed the soybean prices higher indicating a lack of momentum for new highs at this time. Old crop

basis remains strong for both corn and soybeans as farmers are reluctant sellers. This week the Federal Reserve increased interest rates .75% as inflation continues to stress budgets and the economy. Inflation at 8.6% is the highest since 1981. In 1981 we had double digit interest so it is very likely interest will be up again .5% TO 1% at the July meeting of the Federal Reserve. We are just starting to see the first signs of how high fuel prices and inflation are cutting into peoples budgets. Iowa currently has a very high crop conditions rating and these prices are profitable with average yields so be sure to lock in some bushels. We never know when or what will cause prices to fall. Prices always fall much faster than they go up.

Help Finish the Elma Community Complex

The Elma Community Complex Committee is seeking the community's support in raising the final \$125,000 needed to complete the project and is excited to announce another matching opportunity. Joe and Kathy Whiting have graciously pledged another \$100,000 if matching funds can be raised this summer. This is a great opportunity for people to enhance the impact of their donation and help the community finish the Elma Community Complex project.

Local medical services, increased daycare capacity, and fully handicap accessible library adjacent to the daycare and bus-stop are just a few of the ways the Elma area will benefit when this project is complete. The ECC project involves all non-profit organizations and is being done in phases as funding allows. No taxpayer money will be used for this project.

The first phase involved the deconstruction of the former brick school building and was completed in Spring of 2020. The second phase, building a medical clinic on Busti Avenue and in January of 2021 Regional Health Services of Howard County began offering services in Elma in the new building.

The third phase was repurposing a portion of the gymnasium multipurpose community room. This was completed in 2021. The handicap accessible room with kitchenette will be used for library programming for adults and

youth, community meetings and gatherings (city council meetings, family gatherings, etc). Capacity is around 50 people. The community room has served as a temporary location for the three-year-old preschool program until the daycare addition is complete.

The fourth phase involves adding a larger infant room onto the existing daycare and repurposing the current infant room into a 3 year-old-preschool. "The addition to the daycare will allow us the space to go up to 16 infants and more easily separate infants, toddlers and school age kids," shared Sarah Brophy, Daycare Director. "The daycare addition began

last summer and we hope to be using it later this summer."

"We are also in the midst of

renovating the remaining portion of the gym into a library and city clerk's office," shared Renee Burke. "Our current library is not fully handicap accessible and our meeting room seats around 12 people. This location will allow us to be able to expand our programming opportunities, be fully handicap accessible and more easily partner with the daycare on activities for children," shares Renee Burke. She is hopeful to move into this new space this summer too.

"We are currently raising funds for our final phase which include furnishings for the library and daycare along with renovating a bathroom in the hallway, incorporating the murals from the former school building to the outside of the building and with adding landscaping a parking lot on the east and south side. We are hopeful the community will step up one more time and help us finish our project," shared Bruce Weigel, ECC committee member.
