

Corn and Beans

As of this writing, cash corn is \$6.16 ■ and soybeans are \$15.07. Corn is \$.47 higher and soybeans are \$2.35 higher than one month ago. March corn futures are \$6.47 with support at \$6.39 and then at \$6.28, resistance is at \$6.51 and then at \$6.62. March soybean futures are \$15.87 with support at \$15.59 and then at \$15.17, resistance is at \$16.02 and then at ■ \$16.45. So far February has been a ■ wild ride up and down in the grain markets as emotions run high with news highlights about South American weather and crop conditions, Russia activity on the Ukraine border and China's soybean purchases and lack of corn export business. This market is going to be very stressful until it's over and as they say hindsight will be 20/20. Continuing to take risk off the table at these profit levels is my best advice. Typically in a bull

market commodity funds (noncommercials) hold long futures positions and commercials hold short futures positions. During Bull Market peaks funds are very long and commercials are very short. Imagine a stretched rubber band between the two. Funds are typically trend followers which once things change can't exit the market fast enough. The imaginary rubber band snapping lower quickly. Funds net long position isn't quite as large as last year when the markets peaked and commercials aren't record short yet like last year both are getting very close.

The phone number must be in our system. If you don't have a phone number in our computer system you will need to call us to update your information.
